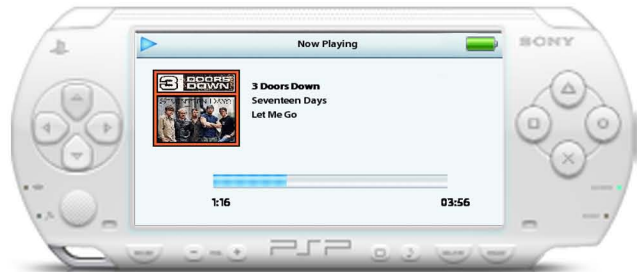
Introduction

Xandu's Media Player - Turn your PSP into an iPod!

Xandu's Media Player was designed to make your PSP look exactly like an iPod.

XMP Features:

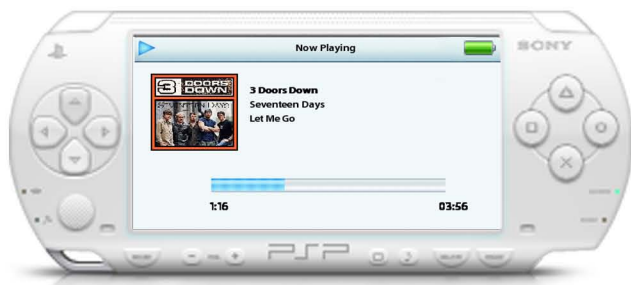
- Mp3 file playback
- WAV file playback
- IT,MOD,S3M playback
- ID3 Tag functions
- iTunes friendly
- Lyrics view
- Music Quiz
- iPod graphics including iPod clickwheel effect
- iPod songbar
- Album Art
- And much, much more to come!



Quick Start

Congratulations on downloading Xandu's Media Player, this section will show you how to use XMP.

1. Copy XMP and XMP% to PSP/GAME150 if you are using Open Edition PSP firmware.
2. Click on the XMP icon from the GAME menu on your PSP.
3. The XMP Menu should appear in front of you!



Adding and managing Music



iTunes is required for using XMP to the max, you can download it at www.apple.com/itunes.

1. To add songs using iTunes, connect the PSP to your PC using Settings > USB mode in the XMP menu.
2. Set iTunes in order to detect your PSP drive.
3. Drag and drop the music you want to iTunes

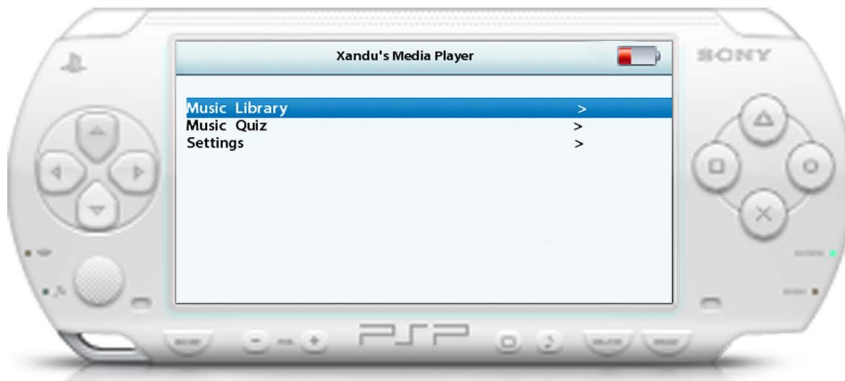
To add Lyrics/Album Art to your song:

1. Right click on the song you want to edit.
2. Click Get info..
3. Edit your song and add album art to it!

Note: It is recommended to use smaller photos

XMP menu information

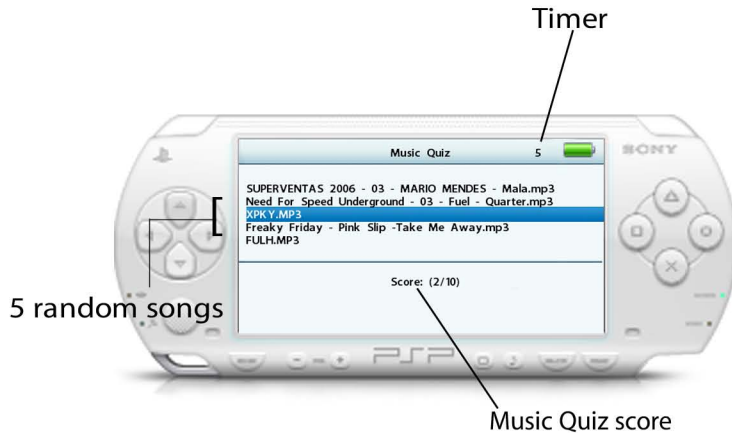
Main Menu:



Music Library: Shows the music files located at your music library.

Music Quiz : Starts Music Quiz, see how much you know your own songs!

Settings: Includes Music Quiz settings and USB mode.



Music Quiz:

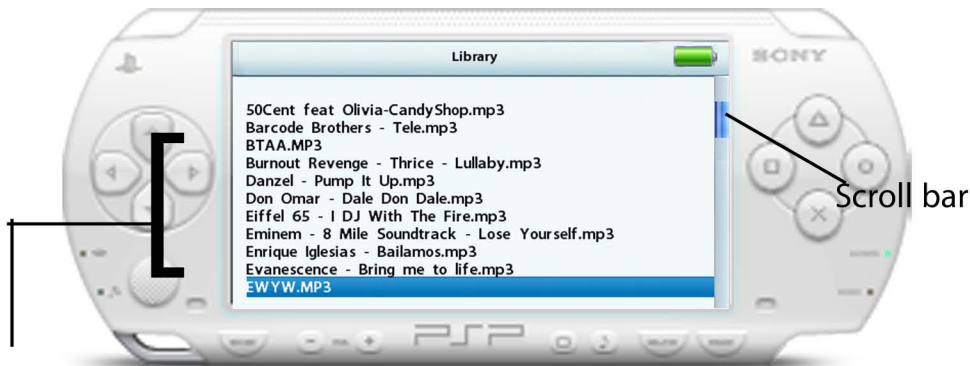
You are given 5 random songs from your library and one of them is playing, choose the right one to score!

To load songs from a specific folder:

Enter the folder you choose from the Music Library.
Press back and then load the Music Quiz.

Music Quiz settings can be modified through the Settings menu.

Music Library



Songs located in your music library, either MUSIC or PSP/MUSIC folders.

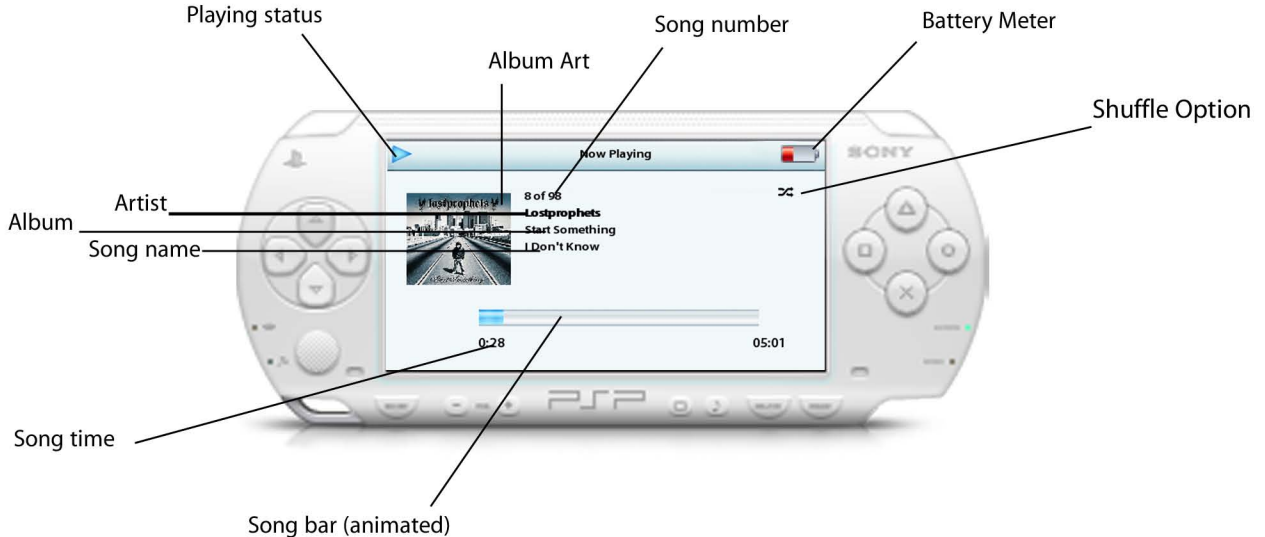
Music Library:

You can scroll through your Library using the D-pad or the Analog Click-Wheel.

To play a song, click X or D-pad in the right direction.

XMP checks if you have music files in MUSIC, if not it will load the files from PSP/MUSIC instead.

Now Playing



Now playing basically shows you all the information needed about the song playing.

To Play/Pause : Start Button

To view Lyrics (if present) : Triangle button

To go back to the Library : Press the left D-pad button

Next/Prev song : Left/Right shoulder triggers

Shuffle Option ON/OFF : Square button

Battery information

The battery meter is shown on the upper right corner of the screen.



Battery is charging



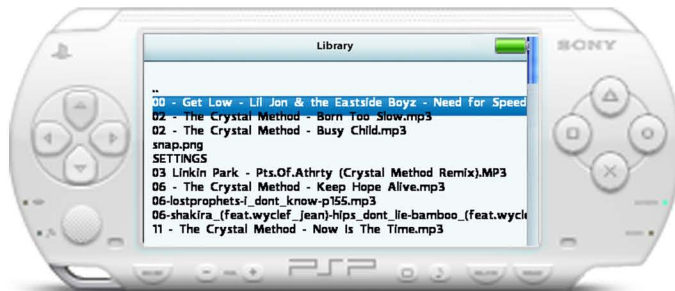
Battery 100%

Troubleshooting

I always get a “JPEG” error in some of my songs.

Make sure that the Album Art picture in the Mp3 file is valid and not too big.

Some of my songs don't display the info correctly,
Artist, Album, Song name.

Make sure that they are valid using iTunes, if this error persists, try converting ID3 Tags to v1.0 by right clicking on the song.

Some of my songs are not visible in the Music Library.

Make sure you have all your music files either in PSP/MUSIC or MUSIC, XMP only reads one of them.

Switching from Now Playing to Library feels slow, is it my PSP?

No, that is a known issue, make sure that you have more than 13 files in your library.

Music Quiz isn't working!

Make sure that you have more than 6 Mp3 files in your library.

I get a “Press start to restart message” and XMP refuses to work!

Make sure that:

1. You have Music files either in MUSIC or PSP/MUSIC.
2. XMP files are in place (PSP/GAME150)
3. Try re-installing XMP.

Troubleshooting

My Lyrics show up in one line, is that my PSP?

No, that is a known issue and will be fixed in future updates, you can scroll the lyrics using up/down on the D-pad.
